NOTES:

- 1. Donations and other public support grossed revenue of \$332 thousand (2020-\$1.895 million). Direct fundraising expenses of \$42,000 (2020-\$132,000) have been netted against this total.
- 2. Donations and other public support include income distribution of \$942,000 (2020 grants received -\$558,000) to the Ontario Paraplegic Foundation, which was established in March 2000 to receive designated bequests and donations from supporters of SCI Ontario. The Foundation is registered under the Income Tax Act and SCI Ontario appoints the majority of the Foundation's Board of Directors. According to the Foundation's bylaws, all resources of the Foundation must ultimately be used for the benefit of SCI Ontario. SCI Ontario's complete audited statements, which are available on our website, include abridged audited statements for the Foundation.
- 3. SCI Ontario is highly dependent on the support of dedicated volunteers. Their value is not quantifiable in the above financial statements.
